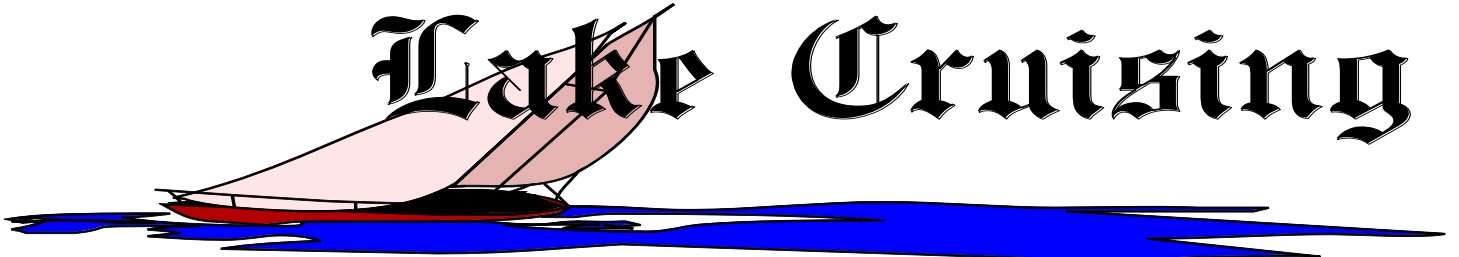

### Veteran's Day

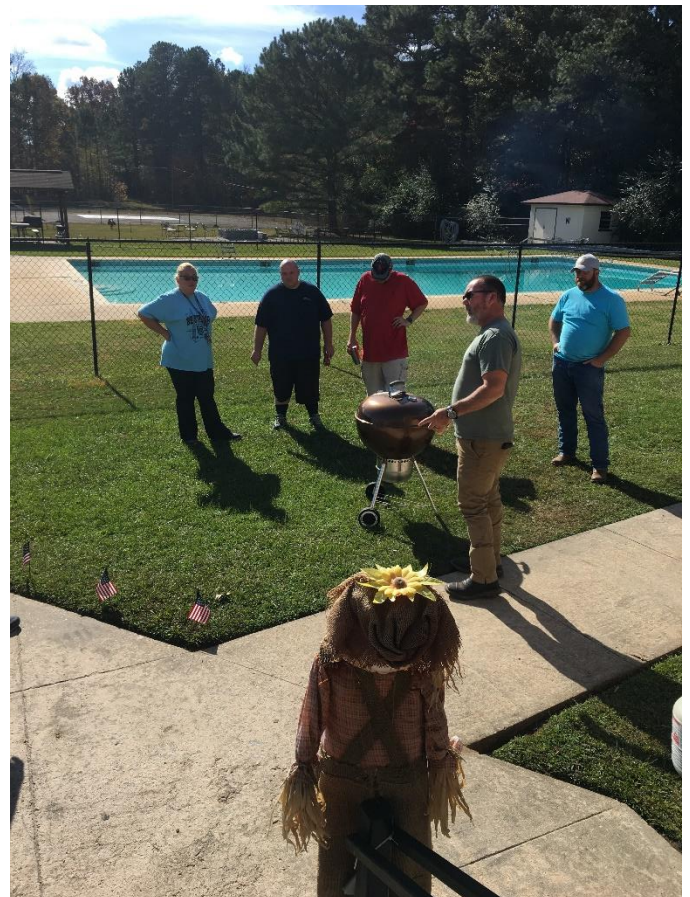
TAPS (submitted by Ron Stottlemire)

In 1862 during the Civil War, on a dark night after a battle in Harris' Landing, VA, Union Army Captain Robert Ellicomb heard the moans of a wounded soldier. He crawled out into the field and dragged the soldier back to camp where he realized it was a dead Confederate soldier. He also then saw it was his son who was studying music in the South and unknown to him, had enlisted in the Confederate Army. He asked his superiors if he could give his son a full military burial; they said no but they would allow one musician, the Captain to chose a bugler. He asked the bugler to play a series of musical notes he found on a piece of paper in his dead son's pocket and what we now know as "TAPS" was born. There were words also, they are:

"Day is done....Gone the sun...From the lakes....From the hills...From the sky...All is well... Safely rest...God is nigh!  
Fading light...Dims the sight...And a star...Gems the sky...Gleaming bright...From afar...Drawing nigh...Falls the night...Thanks and praise...For our days....Neath the sun...Neath the stars...Neath sky....as we go...This we know...God is nigh!"

## Harvest Fest 2020

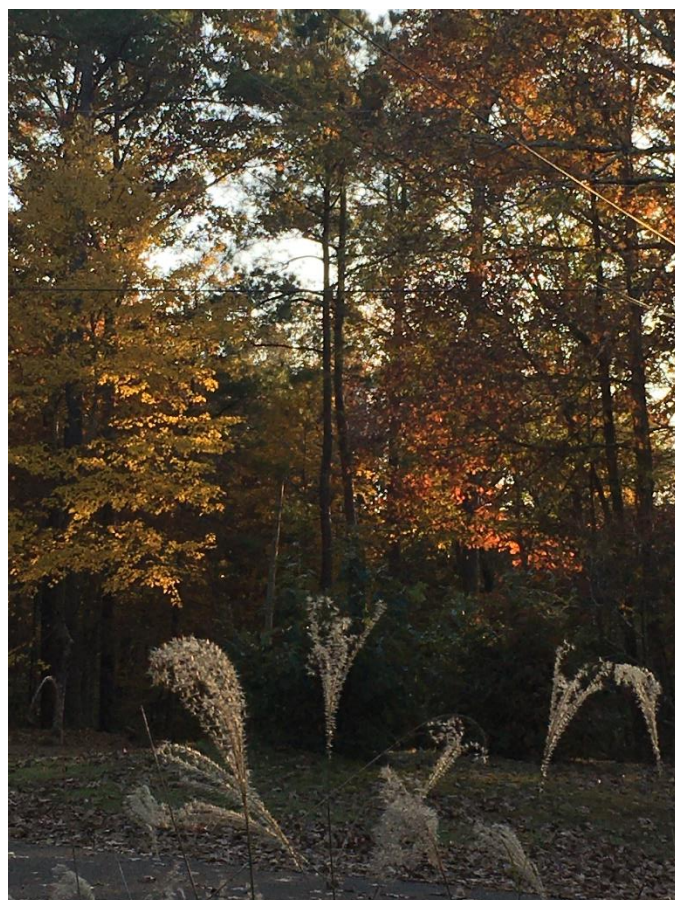
This year's Harvest Fest was a big success with many of the usual games plus some new ones. This was the highest attended Harvest fest we've had in several years.
