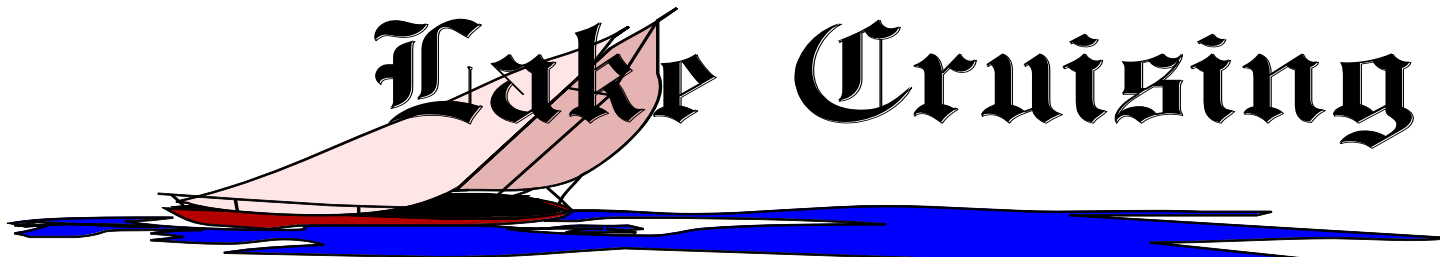

## B & B Ballots and Bills
